

Minutes of a Meeting of the Milton Parish Council held at Willow House, Milton, on 24 Oct. 1944.

There were present: Dr. R. M. Woodman, Chairman, in the chair, & Messrs. B. E. Lander, J. M. Garner, J. Russell, E. J. Warkling, & F. Wilson. The Clerk was absent through indisposition. The Chairman explained that there was now no Parish Room available, & that the Meeting had therefore had to be called at his house.

The Minutes of the previous Meeting were read, confirmed by the Council, & signed by the Chairman.

It was reported that the "Salute the Soldier Week" in Milton had been quite successful.

On the proposition of Mr. Warkling, seconded by Mr. Lander, it was resolved to pay the following Billed:—

- (i) Rent of Allotments to Camb. C.C., due 29 Sept. 1944, £7-12-0; (ii) E. E. Garner, Esq., for repairs, etc., to seat & pump, £6-3-0; (iii) quarterly salary of Warkman, 19s. 6d.; & (iv) quarterly salary of Clerk, £2-5-0.

On the proposition of Mr. Garner seconded by Mr. Russell it was resolved to accept Mr. J. W. Constable's notice to quit Acres of his allotment as from 29 Sept., 1944.

As there was no other business, the Meeting was then declared closed by the Chairman.
