MINUTES

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read, confirmed by the meeting and signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES

A letter was read from the Sanitary Inspector in reply to a written complaint about the condition of ditches in the Parish. It was stated that the cleaning of one ditch had already taken place, the cost of which would be born by a special rate on the Parish. This was objected to on the grounds that the Parish should not have to pay for the cleaning of a private ditch. After some discussion it was resolved that the matter be on the agenda of the next meeting.
