DISTRIBUTION OF FOODSTUFFS FROM THE DOMINIONS. A letter was received from the Chesterton Raral District Council intimating that a consignment of gift foods had been received for distribution to necessitous cases. This food had been allocated between parishes on a population basis, the allocation to hilton being as follows:
