MINUTES. The Minutes of the previous meeting were read, confirmed by the meeting and signed by the Chairman.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING. A letter was received from the County Planning Officer intimating that the County Council would become the authority responsible for Town and Country Planning on the 1st July. The Town and Country Planning Act, 1947 requires the County Council to undertake a survey of the area and prepare a County Development Plan. This matter could best be discussed at a meeting of representatives of Parish Councils proposed to be held in the Shirehall on 3rd April, and representatives from milton were accordingly invited. It was agreed for the Chairman, Mr. L. A. Easy, Mr. S. Siggs and the Clerk to attend this meeting.

GAS SUPPLY. A reply was received from the Gas Company to the effect that owing to an insufficient number of people being interested it was not a sound proposition for them to bring a supply of gas to Milton. The result of a vanvass was as follows:

82 No.

After discussion it was agreed that the Clerk should write to the Gas Company informing them that although the response was disappointing it was felt that if a supply were extended to Milton many more people than had already assented to use gas would do so when a supply was available.
