MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD IN THE SCHOOLROOM ON WEDNESDAY, 24TH MARCH, 1948, AT 8.0 P.M.

There were present:

E. J. Walkling, Esquire, Chairman of Parish Council, in the Messrs. L. A. Easy, D. Pearson, G. H. Pearson, J. Russell, S. A. Siggs, A. W. Wenham and F. Wilson, together with the Clerk of the Parish Council.

The Minutes of the last Annual Meeting held on 28th March, 1947 were read, confirmed by the Meeting and signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES. - Fen Road. Mr. A. W. Wenham proposed that the County Council be urged to carry out the work of improved drainage as soon as possible. Also that their attention be drawn to the water and sand left on the road by lorrees leaving the Fen Road Gravel Pits.

PARISH COUNCIL ACCOUNTS. The Parish Council Accounts for the year ended 31st March, 1947 were presented and unanimously adopted.

MILTON PAROCHIAL CHARITY TRUSTEES ACCOUNTS. The Parochial Chari Accounts for the year ended 31st December, 1947 were examined and The Parochial Charity on the proposition of Mr. J. Russell seconded by Mr. F. Wilson were unanimously adopted.

VILLAGE HALL PLANNING AND BUILDING COMMITTEE. Mr. S. A. Siggs, Chairman of the Planning and Building Committee, gave a resume of the Committee's activities during the past year and appreciation was expressed for the splendid efforts made in accumulating to date the sum of £418-7-82.

Mr. G. H. Pearson put forward a suggestion of forming and Executive Committee consisting of 3 members of the Parish Council and 3 members of the Planning and Building Committee, such Executive to consider ways and means of securing a Recreation Ground and then report to the Parish Council, which body had power This suggestion was considered and it was agreed that the Parish Councillors and Officers of the Planning and Building Committee should form the Executive Committee.

APPOINTMENT OF REPRESENTATIVES TO MILTON VILLAGE HALL PLANNING AND BUILDING COMMITTEE. The 4 members, namely, Mrs. W. Burling, Messrs. L. Edwards, W. Shipp and S. A. Siggs were unanimously re-appointed en bloc.

This concluded the business and the Chairman declared the meeting closed.
