

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD
IN THE SCHOOLROOM ON TUESDAY, 13TH APRIL, 1948 AT
7.30 P.M.

There were present:

ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN. On the proposition of Mr. F. Wilson
seconded by Mr. D. Pearson, Mr. E. J. Walkling was unanimously
elected Chairman for the year.

MINUTES. The Minutes of the last meeting were read, confirmed
by the meeting and signed by the Chairman.

APPOINTMENT OF VICE-CHAIRMAN. Mr. D. Pearson proposed and
Dr. R. M. Woodman seconded that Mr. L. A. Easy be Vice-Chairman.
This was carried unanimously.

RESIGNATION OF MEMORIAL CARETAKER. The resignation of Mr.
B. E. Lander as Memorial Caretaker was accepted with regret; the
Clerk being instructed to send a letter of appreciation to Mr.
Lander for all the care and attention he had given the Memorial.
Discussion followed concerning a successor and it was agreed to
ask the British Legion if one of their members would voluntarily
undertake the work of caring for the Memorial.

WAR MEMORIAL. The British Legion invited the Parish Council to
appoint three of their members to join with three of the British
Legion members and form a War Memorial Fund Committee for the
purpose of adding names to the War Memorial. After
consideration the invitation was declined as it was thought the
British Legion members were fully competent to institute the
work involved.
