

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF MILTON PARISH COUNCIL HELD IN
THE SCHOOLROOM ON TUESDAY, 4TH MAY, 1948, AT 8.0 P.M.

There were present:

Mr. E. J. Walkling, Chairman, in the Chair;
Messrs. L. A. Easy, D. Pearson, J. Russell and A. W. Wenham, together
with the Clerk.
Mr. F. Wilson was prevented by illness from attending.

MINUTES. The Minutes of the last meeting were read, confirmed by
the meeting and signed by the Chairman.

DISTRIBUTION OF GIFT FOODSTUFFS. An allocation of 65 tins of
Foodstuffs was received from the Chesterton Rural District
Council. After careful consideration these were distributed
amongst people living alone, households consisting of 2 persons
and a few old age pensioners.

REVISION OF COUNTY COUNCIL RENT. Intimation was received from the
County Land Agent that it was proposed to increase the rent to
sitting tenants by 10% as from Michaelmas 1948. The Clerk was
instructed to reply that in the opinion of the Council the present
rent was adequate and fair for the type of land hired and no
increase was justified.

CAMBRIDGESHIRE PARISH COUNCILS' ASSOCIATION. The Annual Meeting
of the Association was arranged for 22nd May and Mr. L. A. Easy
and the Clerk were elected to attend.

MONIES RECEIVED. The Clerk reported the receipt of £1. 17s. 6d.
being rent due at Lady Day 1948 from Mr. H. Easy.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS. The Annual Meeting of Cambridgeshire Playing
Fields Association was arranged for 27th May, 1948 and Mr. L. A.
Easy and Mr. D. Pearson were elected to attend.

The Clerk was instructed to ascertain whether Mr. V. Shipp
had sub-let part or whole of the allotments hired by him contrary
to the terms of his signed agreement.

Complaint was again made about the smell from the ditch in
Fen Road; the Clerk being instructed to write to the Sanitary
Officer of the Chesterton Rural District Council.

A letter had been received from the County Surveyor
explaining that because a sewerage scheme for Milton had been
proposed any reconstruction work in Fen Road would be deferred on
that account. The Clerk was instructed to keep this matter before
the appropriate authority.

This concluded the business and the Chairman declared the
meeting closed.
