FEN ROAD DITCH. The condition of the ditch in Fen Road opposite  
the School again came up for consideration and as the Chesterton  
Rural District Council decline to make any improvements because of  
the pending sewerage scheme it was felt if a channel could be  
cleared in the New River which would then allow the water to get  
away freely, this would alleviate the nuisance to a considerable  
degree. The Clerk was therefore instructed to communicate with  
the Manager of the Eastern Electricity Board Fens Sub Area  
suggesting this remedy and asking if they could help in the matter.
