

Minutes of a meeting of Milton  
Parish Council held in the  
Schoolroom on Monday 20th No-  
vember 1950. at 7 p.m.

Minutes.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read,  
confirmed by the meeting and signed by the Chairman.

Matters arising from Minutes.

Street Lighting. The Clerk reported that the  
Chesterton Rural District Council had acknowledged  
the communication with reference to an additional  
street lamp.

Bus Stop. The Clerk reported that he had had  
a visit from an inspector of the Eastern Counties  
Omnibus Company who had reported that bus stop signs  
would be erected in due course. As regards the extra  
bus stop, enquiries were being made of the various  
authorities concerned.

Recreation Ground.

The Chairman reported that the Chesterton Rural  
District Council had given consideration to the  
acquisition of O.S.P. 139 as a Recreation Ground,  
but in the opinion of their member who was an expert  
on recreation grounds it was considered that the area  
of  $3\frac{1}{2}$  acres was not adequate for the purpose. Accord-  
ingly the Council further considered the matter and after  
a good deal of discussion it was recommended that  
sufficient of the fields to the South and West of O.S.P.  
139, namely O.S.P.'s 138 and 149 be acquired, which,  
together with O.S.P. 139 would give a compact area of  
approximately 6 acres. It was further agreed that Mr.  
S. A. Siggs contact Mr. Orbell the Deputy County  
Planning Officer, and enquire as to the planning pro-  
posals in regard to this area.

This concluded the business and the Chairman  
declared the meeting closed.
