Surveyor & on the proposition of Mr J. Eldon seconded by
Mr W. H. Casey it was unanimously resolved that Mr Geo.
Wilson be the other Surveyor.

Appointment of Assistant Overseer.

On the proposition of Mr J. Eldon seconded by Mr G. Wilson
it was unanimously resolved that Mr W. H. Casey be the
Assistant Overseer & on the proposition of Mr C. J. Abbit
seconded by Mr J. Eldon it was unanimously resolved that
his remuneration be £8 (eight pounds).
