Mr W. H. Garry it was unanimously resolved that Mr Geo.  
Wilson be the other Surveyor.

#### Appointment of Assistant Overseer.

On the proposition of Mr J. Gladson seconded by Mr G. Wilson  
it was unanimously resolved that Mr Wm. Garry be the  
Assistant Overseer. & on the proposition of Mr C. Hobbit -  
seconded by Mr J. Gladson it was unanimously resolved that  
his remuneration be £8 (eight pounds).

On the proposition of Mr J. Elddon seconded by Mr G. Yellett  
it was unanimously resolved that before striking any Plate  
the Assistant Overseer be ordered to lay full particulars  
thereof before the council.

On the proposition of Mr J. Elddon seconded by Mr G. Wilson  
it was unanimously resolved that the respective Balances of  
the Surveyor & Overseer be paid to the credit of the Parish  
Council Account.

Surveyors may have to draw — Two signatures to be
