Dear Sir,

Your of the 10th Inst. was considered at a meeting
held yesterday evening and I am to inform you that the
place referred to is the Property of Milton Parish and has
been kept in repair at its expense as long as anyone in the
Village can remember — He could under under no circumstances
allow your Council to interfere with any of the Rights of this
Parish without taking immediate proceedings — I am to give you
notice that as we understand some of your men have interfered
with our Parish Hackens thus letting the effluent Sewage Water into our
Drains for the Stock to drink if this occurs again action will at once
be taken — I am also to add that your letter does not seem to correspond
with the Resolution of your Council as appears in the Local Papers —
On the proposition of Mr Jebbit seconded by
Mr Nelson it was resolved that this meeting
be adjourned until to-morrow evening.
