

July 18 - 1896.

A letter was read from the Rev. Whitney dated Jan. 30. 1896 - offering to exchange a piece of ground for a Burial Ground.

A letter was read from the Chesterton Urban District Council enquiring whether a Committee would meet at their Board Room & it was resolved that the Clerk write and inform them that we are considering certain alterations and until these are settled we do not think we can meet as suggested.

The Chairman reported that he had attended a meeting of the Conservators in reference to the removal of the Slacker near Sewsbury & he was satisfied that they had no desire to interfere with us in any way but simply desire it to protect the well - and it was arranged that the Slacker should be replaced immediately the effluent sewage water was taken from the Ditch.
