all fees & perquisites & to include Renting Bamsters &c.
on the proposition of Mr Eldon seconded by Mr Gooden
it was resolved that the Rents due for the Ten Bank
from Messrs: Sanders, Melken & Redfern be left in
the hands of the Chairman to settle.

It was resolved upon the proposition of Mr Eldon
seconded by Mr Jebbit that the Chairman be empowered
to approach the Parish Councils of Sandbach and
Bottlenham in reference to the construction of a Light

Railway to run from the crossing on the Melton Road
thru Landbeach via Bray Lane to Cottenham.
