Feedback from District Councillor Hazel Smith. -

Environmental Health meeting I went to confirmed the level of grants. We are in competition with other similar schemes for the money available, so they set up criteria to judge the schemes. There was a judgement on the number of clients each scheme served - in future it would be to our advantage in terms of the grant awarded to have at least 20 clients on the scheme. They also look at the level of contribution the clients pay and £4 or £5 was typical

6. Barnabas Court update:

Report from Hazel.

Barnabas Court matters: the service charge has gone up by 30% but there is nothing we can do to change this. To some extent it is because the winter 2012-13 was a harsh one and heating costs were high. Some of this is apparently paid as an average across the tenants with the cost being worked out in September and applied from the following April. It may be expected to go down next year as this last winter was a mild one, but they would not consider evening out the payment. They had a tenants meeting on the 24th April to discuss this
