# 4. Approval of Minutes from the Maintenance Committee meeting on 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2014:

## **Matters arising:**

#### Cemetery:

Decision to move to a weekly black bin collection: Ongoing.

Compost heap in the middle of the cemetery is very full and needs clearing: Ongoing.

Grave digging company to mark out the plots on right-hand side as well as all non-purchased graves on left-hand side: Partially done, to be completed before Christmas.

Clerk to look into a water supply and the possibility of benches on the new side of the cemetery: Ongoing. It was **AGREED** 

G Heaney to send a letter to the Smith family to cover three issues: 1. Possibility of new bench and water supply; 2. Removal of flowers outside of grave area; 3. Clarity of headstone size and design.

## 5. Allotments

Discussion on removal of conifers from remaining allotments. It was **AGREED** 

to contact tenants of A4 and E4/E5 to remove remaining conifers (including goldcrest conifer hedges).

Discussion about use of tyres on plots: tyres to be used for planting purposes but not dumped/stockpiled.

#### 6. Play

Discussion on repair of play equipment quote from Fenland Leisure. It was **AGREED** 

to contact Paul Capitain to review quote and see what work he can do.

#### 7. Buchans

Discussion of Buchans grass-cutting contract. JE Coston commented that Buchans has been doing a very good job for the village. It was **AGREED** (**propose G Heaney**; **second DJ Chamberlin**)

to accept up to 1% increase in Buchans' fees for 2015.

G Heaney and JE Coston to meet with Buchans for revised plan of all areas they tend in the village as well as discussion on grass-cutting of North Lodge Park football pitches. Item to be put on March Maintenance Committee agenda for tender of future grass-cutting contract.

## 8. Budget

Discussion of estimates for 2015 Maintenance budget. It was **AGREED** (propose G Heaney; second M Perkins) to allocate
