110/06 **2 Declarations of Interest** – RHC min 112/06 allotments – personal (had submitted quotation for restoring roadway).

111/06 **3 Minutes** – RHC was included in “apologies for absence” - the minutes of the meeting of 19th September 2005 were approved and signed as a true record.

112/06 **4 Allotments – roadway**
Committee could not justify spending any money on the roadway. It was therefore **AGREED** (5 votes in favour 1 abstention)

not to repair the roadway.

Noted that the bridge over the drain had been damaged.

113/06 **5 Brick Bus Shelters: High Street near Waggon & Horses and Cambridge Road**
AGREED

to ask T Nicholls to quote for replacing the tops of the seats in both shelters and removing ivy from the shelter in High Street. *Action: the clerk*

The Chairman would authorise work if within his budget. *Action: PKO*

Committee decided to do nothing about the graffiti; would monitor state of roofs.

114/06 **6 Boundary fence near 100 - 106 The Sycamores**
The boundary fence was broken in places. As it was not needed it was **AGREED** to ask T Nicholls to remove it completely. Committee confirmed that it was not necessary for the clerk to advise the residents nearby that the work was scheduled to be done.

115/06 **7 Request to clear footpaths /cycle paths near Butt Lane**
AGREED

to ask village cleaner to sweep up leaves and debris from foot/cycle path between Froment Way (by Mansfield Close) and Butt Lane and to include this in his schedule of work once per year;
to ask residents to cut back overhanging trees / shrubs;
to ask Buchans to cut back shrubs from the footpath between Faulkner Close and Butt Lane; and
to ask residents to cut back overhanging shrubs from foot path adjacent 255 The Rowans and 110 The Sycamores. *Action: the clerk*

116/06 **8 AOB**
Bins – Fire Expire Plates – these are replaced whenever necessary.
Trees rear of Tesco – HMS reported that if MCC asked for a quotation for pruning trees on the Sycamores recreation ground next to their wall Tesco would make a contribution.
