C/11/40/072 Mr Payne, PI Shurlock Ltd, Milton Hall – London plane tree to rear of Milton Hall – reduce crown by 25%. Trees officer RLEW recommends no comment – AGREED **no comment.**

S/0467/13/CM Chesterton Rail Freight Sidings, Chesterton Junction, Cowley Road, Cambridge CB4 0DL – proposed reconfiguration and consolidation of the existing minerals processing and transfer operation including the installation of covered mineral storage bays, alterations and extensions to existing feeder unit. New office, welfare and workshop buildings, reconfiguration of site circulation and parking area, new boundary fencing and other works associated with relocating rail sidings to serve the mineral processing site.

Milton Parish Council would like a seat on the Local Liaison Forum to be set up. Milton Parish Council supports the idea of a road bridge over the railway to access Chesterton Fen instead of the current level crossing.

S/1176/13/FL Mr & Mrs Joe Upton, The Old Coal Yard, Chesterton Fen Road, Chesterton – demolition of dwelling and erection of 2 bedroom bungalow. **No recommendation.**

S/2274/13/FL Mr Richard Boyd, 8 High Street, Milton – Erection of a dwelling. No recommendation. The dwelling could be more central on the plot to avoid shade issues for neighbouring garden. Concern regarding condition of access road to the dwelling.

S/2359/13/FL Mr Gulshan Chowdury, 34 Froment Way, Milton – extension of house to join existing outbuilding. **No recommendation.**

S/2463/13/LD Mr Graham Lay, 3 Coulson Close, Milton – Single storey side/rear extension – opportunity to provide any relevant local information to assist SCDC in considering this application for a Lawful Development Certificate. **No comments were raised.**

S/2570/13/FL Mr & Mrs T Whybrow, 5 Old School Lane, Milton – Two storey side extension. **No recommendation.**

6. Joint Development Control Committee Meeting

AGREED to ask for an estimate of the total legal fee for CHS's solicitor to draft the deed of variation and also an estimate of the total legal fees for the council's solicitor for the work carried out for this project. Any contribution towards CHS legal fees to be agreed at next council meeting on 13th January 2014 (proposed RJF, seconded HMS).
