

Report of the meeting of the Cemetery Committee on Tuesday  
February 13th 1990.

Present: Rev. F. Kilner, Mrs. J.E. Coston, E.M.C. Dunlop,  
Mrs. S.J. Snaith and the clerk S.J. Daniels

The following guidelines were drawn up for administration of  
Milton Cemetery.

1. The cemetery to be for all.

2. Fees

| Interment of ashes   | £20  |
| Tablet erected vertically or horizontally<br>up to 18" x 18" commemorating person<br>cremated  | £15  |
| Any other monument not exceeding 30" x 18"<br>with simple inscription following the style<br>recommended by the Church Commissioners | £30  |
| Headstone for a child up to 18 years   | £5   |
| Inscription on any monument added on a<br>later occasion   | £10  |

All fees to be double for non residents.  
Fees to be reviewed every five years.

N.B. A reserved plot with exclusive rights of burial  
for a period of 100 years may be purchased for £100.  
(This includes the fee for interment).

3. Records. The clerk to the Council would keep all necessary  
registers and a grid map of all grave spaces including the  
area set aside for interment of ashes.

Authority would be invested in the clerk to issue all necessary  
certificates and documentation.

4. Access. Markers to denote the roadway for vehicular access  
should be set into the ground. A path/road capable of carrying  
a vehicle would be the long term aim.

The Committee recommended that these regulations be accepted by  
Council in place of those agreed on 11 April 1984.
