## Report of a Meeting of the Cemetery Committee held on Wednesday 14 February 1996

It was agreed to amend the guidelines as drawn up on 13 February 1990 as follows:

Ashes. Ashes to be buried in a straight line starting along the western side of the hedge that divides the old from the new with 30 centimetres between rows. Tablets 45cms by 30cms and dark granite to be erected horizontally. Inscriptions to follow the style recommended by the Church Commissioners.

Interment of an adult	
Interment of a child up to 18yrs	
Interment of ashes (£30) and tablet (£20)	
Any other monument not exceeding 76cms x 46cms	
Headstone for a child up to 18 yrs	
Inscription on any monument added on a later occasion	£10

All fees to be double for non residents.

Purchase of exclusive rights of burial includes the fee for interment.

Footnote: At the City Cemetery a burial cost £200. Exclusive rights of burial costs in addition £250 for residents and £600 for non residents. Exclusive rights means that if a person wishes to reserve a plot it would cost in Cambridge £250. At the time of burial another £200 would be payable. Both Impington and Waterbeach charge a separate fee for exclusive rights but their fees are still well below ours.

## Roadway.
