- 3. 148/93 Vice Chair. R.T.S. proposed D.J.L. seconded and all agreed that R.J.F. be elected vice chairman. D.T.W. thanked R.T.S. for his help whilst vice chairman.

  D.T.W. congratulated J.E.C. on becoming County Councillor.
- 4. 149/93 Bus Project. Dawn Sampford and Nicky Parker from Histon (127/93)

  Baptist Church attended to explain the rationale behind the Bus Project which was a scheme aimed at helping young people in the Pepys Patch. A. Allen of I.V.C. wished to be involved in the scheme.

  The organisers were looking for sponsorship and donationa towards the cost of purchasing and setting up a bus (c. £10,000) and annual running costs (£3-4,000).

  Volunteers wishing to be trained as youth workers on the bus were also needed.

  It was agreed to ask a representative of All Saints Church to attend the next meeting to discuss the possibility of a joint approach.
