MINUTES.

The Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 22nd March 1955, were confirmed and signed.

PARISH COUNCIL ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 1955.

The Clerk presented the audited Accounts for the year ended 31st March 1955. These were examined and adopted.

MILTON PAROCHIAL CHARITIES ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER, 1955.

The Clerk presented the Accounts of Milton Parochial Charities for the year ended 31st December, 1955. After examination these were unanimously adopted.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT.

The Chairman gave a resume of the work done by the Parish Council during the year. This included the provision of street-nameplates; the development of land in Fen Road for housing; the provision of lighting and a bus timetable in the Cambridge Road bus shelter and also a promise by the Rural District Council of two additional street lights for erection at the Post Office and at Milton Laundry.

MILTON SCHOOL.

Mrs. Pearson gave a brief report as the Parish Council's representative on the School Managing Body. This included a reference to the visit of a representative

from the County Council Education Committee who outlined the progress made towards the building of a new school on a site in Butt Lane. It was hoped that building would commence during the coming financial year.

IMPINGTON VILLAGE COLLEGE.

Mr. S. A. Siggs gave a report on the work of the Governing Body during the previous year. He emphasised the difficulties due to overcrowding at the College, but these were being gradually overcome as new building progressed. Despite this overcrowding he was favourably impressed during his visits by the standard of education attained and the behaviour of the students.

This concluded the business and the Chairman declared the meeting closed.
