The Minutes of the meeting held on the 12th October 1953, were confirmed and signed.

Matters arising from Minutes

18. Village Pump. The Clerk reported he had negotiated with the War Office Claims' Commission, who had agreed to pay half the cost of removing the pump, namely, £2.12. 6. in full and final settlement of the claim.

19. War Memorial. The Clerk was instructed to arrange for the replanting of the War Memorial and the Chairman and Mr. A. Wayman kindly offered the plants for this.

20. Bus Shelter
Mr. S. A. Siggs submitted a design for a bus shelter. The cost of materials for a shelter 12' x 5' amounted to £68, or with provision for a window at each end £73. As this figure exceeded the amount available for the scheme, it was agreed to revise the design and submit to the next meeting. In the meantime the Clerk to seek Miss E. M. Robinson's permission to erect the shelter on the green opposite the Wagon and Horses public house. It was also agreed for the Clerk to explore the possibility of enlisting voluntary labour for erecting the shelter.
