942. APOLOGY FOR ABSENCE.

An apology for absence was received from Mrs. D. Pearson.

943. MINUTES.

The Minutes of the meeting held on 15th September, 1964, were read, confirmed by the Meeting and signed by the Chairman.

944. MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES.

Ditch at Rear of Coles Road. - Information was received from Chesterton Rural District Council that they had contacted the two site developers, Messrs. Gray Conoley & Co: Ltd:, and Messrs. Jack Green (Builders) Ltd; regarding this matter. The latter company intimated that the ditch was outside the boundary of their property, but the former company had consulted their Colicitors from whom they were awaiting a reply.

945. Sale of Village Hall Site - The Clerk submitted the District Valuer's report in connection with the proposed sale of this property, and on the understanding that the purchaser pays the Council's proper legal costs he valued the site at £2,000 and was prepared to recommend a sale on this basis. This report had been submitted to the Ministry of Housing and Local Government, whose consent to the sale was now awaited.

946. Parish Guide - Mr. Forbes reported that the Rural District Council had now agreed to print 600 copies of the Parish Guide.

947. Speed of Traffic - Cambridgeshire Constabulary reported that as a result of special attention given to this matter nine drivers had been reported for exceeding the speed limit and that the patrols were being continued. It was agreed a letter of thanks be sent to the Chief Constable.

948. Seats for War Memorial - The Clerk submitted prices and illustrations of seats and was authorised to order two of the type B56A from Messrs. E. W. Tyler & Co. Ltd., Tonbridge, at a cost of £11 each. It was proposed that these be erected on the War Memorial site.

949. STACKING OF STRAW BALES AT BENE'T FARM.

Mr. Wenham reported that the residents in Bene't Close complained of the danger from fire as the result of the stacking of straw bales in close proximity to their homes. They felt so strongly in this matter that they had organised a petition, signed by the Bene't Close residents, and had submitted this to Mr. Harold Easy.

While the Council considered this was a matter outside their province it was agreed the Clerk write to Mr. Easy asking him to give consideration to the anxiety of the parents in the event of fire.

- Applicant: Meads and Shaw on behalf of Cambridge Greyhound Racing.
 Description: Outline for covered stand and clubroom for racing stadium 12.5 acres approx.
 Location: O.S.P.P 275, Chesterton Fen Road, Milton.
 Comments: Opposed to the application on the grounds that the approach road is not only through a thickly populated area, but the volume of traffic likely to arise could, and no doubt would be aggravated by the periodic closing of the railway crossing gates. In addition, it is not considered desirable to introduce a sport such as greyhound racing into the Chesterton Fen area.
- Applicant: Mr. G. W. Gardiner
 Description: Extension to rear of existing shop and living accommodation of shop store, lounge, bathroom and kitchen, etc.
 Location: Bene't Stores, 59, Cambridge Road, Milton.
 Comments: No observations.
- Applicant: Mr. D. Parsons.
 Description: Parking of one residential caravan.
 Location: Long Reach House (Pt. O.S.P. 302), Chesterton Fen Road, Milton.
 Comments: View with disfavour the sporadic siting of caravans in this area and feel that the spread of the caravan population should be discouraged.
- Applicant: Mr. C. R. Holliday
 Description: Parking of two caravans for residential use
 Location: Chesterton Fen Road, Milton (Pt. O.S.P. 275)
 Comments: Disapprove of the application on the grounds that sporadic siting of caravans in this area should be discouraged, and instead the applicants who have occupied the site for some years now should be encouraged to provide permanent dwellings.
- Applicant: Mr. A. E. Harris
 Description: Development of site for use as petrol filling station with kiosk and service bay
 Location: Village Hall Site, junction of Waterbeach and Landbeach Road (Pt. O.S.P. 59), Milton.
 Comments: No observations.

 Description: Erection of single storey dwelling after demolition of existing building
 Location: 53, Cambridge Road, Milton.
 Comments: No observations.
