

A MEETING OF MILTON PARISH COUNCIL HELD IN THE VILLAGE HALL  
ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 5th., 1972, at 7.30 p.m.

Present: Mrs. M. Jones & Mrs. B.C. Watersen; Messrs P. Kiddle & R.T. Summerfield; and the Clerk.

Apologies were received from the Chairman and Vice-Chairman (Messrs D. Pearson and M.M. Forbes); Messrs H.W.H. Easy, M.J.D. Nurse and A.W. Wenham.

2034 - APPOINTMENT OF CHAIR- On the proposal of Mr. Summerfield  
MAN FOR THE MEETING. seconded by Mrs. Watersen, Mrs. Jones was unanimously elected.

2035 - CIRCULATED MINUTES OF These were approved by the meeting  
MEETING OF NOVEMBER 4th, 1972 and signed by the Chairman.

2036 - PARISH IN- The Clerk reported that he had sent an In-  
SURANCES (2014) surance proposal embodying the cover agreed  
(see Min. 2014) to the Cornhill Insurance  
Company with effect as from Dec. 1st, together with cheque for  
£11.60. - being 50% of the Annual Premium, as required, signed  
by the Chairman and Vice-Chairman. The Council approved this  
action.

2037 - WASTE LAND Messrs Few & Kester reported that transfer  
COLES RD. (2024) documents were being prepared for exchange  
and legal costs were estimated at about £40.

On the proposition of Mr. Summerfield, seconded by Mr. Kiddle, the Clerk was instructed to ask Messrs Few & Kester if the transfer documents could be exchanged without further delay.

2038 - 'BUS FOR SCHOOL- The Clerk reported that Mrs. Kearney was  
CHILDREN TO IMPINGTON hopeful that parents would support a  
COLLEGE (2028) service offered by Premier Travel Ltd  
at £6 a day. She now required to nego-  
tiate with that Company on the collection of fares and needed  
the names and addresses of the Milton parents concerned. The  
Clerk had agreed to help with these two items.

2039 - PROPOSED GYPSY The Clerk submitted a draft reply to the  
CARAVAN SITE (2029) Planning Consultation Notice (C/72/1374/0  
- OSP 1458, MILTON) which the Council carefully considered and  
amended. It was then approved and the Clerk instructed to  
despatch it to the County Planning Dept. and the Dept. of the  
Environment together with copies of the residents' petition.

2040 - COUNTY COUNCIL Consequent upon the Breach of Tenancy  
ALLOTMENTS (2030) Notice served upon the Clerk he read a  
letter prepared for distribution to all  
Allotment tenants urging them to be responsible to remedy the bad  
cultivation alleged by the Co. Land Agent and commending those  
to which this did not apply. The Council approved the letter  
and agreed it be sent out.
