

In accordance with MIN. 2357, Mr. Kiddle, Mr. Nurse and the Clerk met the Committee of Management sub-Committee (Mr. David Jones, Chairman, Mrs. D. Jones, Messrs B. Connor, Hon. Sec., Mr. Douglas Jones & Mr. G. Patten, Chairman of the C. of Mgt.)

The meeting heard from the sub-Committee that they had not realised that it was their responsibility to apply for grants (beyond the forms they had completed for Mr. Forbes) and, from the Clerk and P.C. representatives, that the Parish Council had agreed that the C. of Mgt. were the appropriate sponsors of the scheme and responsible for the financing and payment of a/cs.

The misunderstanding was regretted on 'both sides of the table' and attention was turned towards procedure now to be followed.

There was doubt as to whether a DC grant was implied in the letter from the County Education Officer to the C. of Mgt. Treasurer, of 29 November last. It was finally agreed that the CofMgt. accept responsibility for the CRS project and the Clerk agreed, at the Hon. Secs. request, to make inquiries about the DC grant position and follow up the letter of 29 Nov. for further elucidation. Mr. Patten asked as a matter of urgency for a Report from the Clerk on his inquiries on behalf of the C. of Mgt., for the latter's meeting next evening, April, 9.

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Clerk's Report following above meeting.

The Clerk made inquiries urgently from the County Education Office and SCDC.

C. Ed. Office - He clarified the position with Mr. Male (writer of the letter of 29 Nov.) who confirmed that the 1442 is the CC grant. He also confirmed that the C. of Mgt. application form (referred to in para. 2 of Meeting Report, above) stated that ~~the~~ a CRDC grant had been applied for. If this was not so it reduced the amount of DES "doubling" grant when announced. Confirmation of the DES grant was awaited by him (Mr. Male) the original confirmation date of January being held over until after April 1 so that new Councils could deal with them. He hoped that, if no hitches occurred, confirmation of both the 1442, and the DES grant, would be made by the CC Leisure and Amenities Committee at 'end of April'.

SCDC - The Clerk understood from the SCDC that application forms were to be printed and he asked for the necessary forms to be sent to the Treasurer of the C. of Mgt., Mr. D. Jones. He was told that when application was received it would go, together with all other such applications from various bodies, before the General Purposes Committee on May 9 next.
