

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF MILTON PARISH COUNCIL HELD IN
THE VILLAGE HALL, COLES ROAD, ON TUESDAY, MARCH 12th.,
1968, at 7.15 p.m.

There were present: Mr.D.Pearson, in the Chair; Mrs. M.Jones, Messrs L.M.Forbes, J.W.R.Lewis, and E.J.Walkling together with the Clerk. Apologies for absence were received from Mr.J.S.Doggett (through illness) and Mr. R.T.Summerfield.

1402

MINUTES (1366)

The circulated minutes of the Council meeting of January 3rd. were confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

1403

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

1403

Waste Land, Coles Road (1295) - The Clerk reported that he had heard nothing from Messrs Gray, Connolly's solicitors since the last meeting and was still unable to obtain a definite answer; the whole matter appeared to rest on the planning permission they required. The Clerk was instructed to let the matter rest.

1404

Sale of old Village Hall Site (1368) - The Clerk reported that permission had at last been received from the Ministry of Local Government for the sale to be completed. Messrs W.J. & J.G.Taylor had informed the Clerk that the cheque for balance of purchase money would be forwarded.

It was proposed by Mr.E.J.Walkling and seconded by Mrs M.Jones that the Council pay all legal charges.

1405

Naming of new estate off Fen Road (1369)- The Clerk reported that he understood from the R.D.C. that the Parish Council's suggestion of 'Hall End' had been approved.

1406

Milton Road Crossing (1382) - The Clerk reported that British Railways had replied that the warning lamps were standard and they had checked the focussing. They asked if the lamp on the Cambridge side was satisfactory.

1407

Eastern Electricity, Development at Milton Hall (1311)
The Clerk said that they had again been ignored by the County Planning Office over this development despite assurances in their letter of apology of 2nd. June 1967 that they would refer detailed application by Eastern Electricity to the Council.

It now appeared that the County Planning Office in consultation with Ministry of Transport and Eastern Electricity had not approved an alternative to the Church Lane gate to the Eastern Electricity premises and the Parish Council were therefore unaware of these talks.

The Clerk reported that he had had a discussion with Mr.H.T.Ransley, Manager of Eastern Electricity about their developments who authorised him to tell the Council that after detailed consideration of various alternative routes exits and entrances no alternative other than existing one could be agreed between Eastern Electricity and County Planning.

The Clerk was instructed to invite Mr. Ransley to meet the Council at their next meeting.

1408 Landbeach Road Cemetery (1275) - The Clerk was instructed to send a
send a letter of appreciation of the voluntary work put in by
the Parochial Church Council in renovations at the Cemetery.

1409 PARISH COUNCILS ASSOCIATION, SPRING CONFERENCE

The Clerk drew attention to a brief circulated report on this
meeting which he had attended.

1410 BEST KEPT VILLAGE COMPETITION

The Council decided not to enter this competition.

1411m 6A MBRIDGE ROAD ENTRANCE RECREATION GROUND

The Clerk had received an estimate from the R.D.C for the
levelling and removal of soil, of £10, followed by fort-
nightly cutting at 10s per cut. The Council agreed to acc-
ept this.
