MTG. of COUNCIL, 12 November, 1974 in VILLAGE HALL at 7.30 p.m.

Present: DP (Chmn.); JGC, HWHE, LMF, MEJ, PK, MJDN, RTS; Apology: BCW.  
Mr. L. Clarke (Pembroke Hse.) also in attendance. (ref:2528)

MINUTES of Mtg. of Tuesday, October 1 confirmed and signed.

2529 STOKES' APPEAL Agreed: a special meeting of Planning Sub-Comm.  
PROCEEDINGS (2519) be held on TUESDAY, 19 November, 51 Old School  
Lane at 8 p.m.

2530 CHANGING ROOMS PK reported: progress with Phase 1; brickwork to  
PROJECT (2509) damp-course level & water being laid; accounts  
available for inspection.

2531 FATAL ACCIDENT IN Clerk reported that he had informed the Coroner  
HIGH STREET (2520) of the Council's grievance at the poor response  
received to our appeal to remove the dangers  
contributing to the many accidents in High Street and had attended the  
Inquest. The Coroner had put certain of our suggestions to the Police but  
had, necessarily, confined the Clerk's statements to those relevant to  
the particular accident the Inquest was concerned with.

The Chmn. asked Mr. L. Clarke for comments after which the Council agreed  
to write again to the Chief Constable asking why no reply had been recd.  
to their letter of November, 1973 & to press for a reply & mtg. with the  
Council; also to find out why Mr. Clarke's petition against the Speed Lim-  
it raising ( 314 signatures ) had not reached the Regional Controller  
at Bedford.

Mr. Clarke also suggested the 'ROAD NARROWS' signs near his house should  
be moved further towards Ely as they gave insufficient warning and the  
road was actually narrower at that spot.

2532 "LOCAL COUNCIL ADMINISTRATION" This important reference volume,  
- LOCAL COUNCILS ASSOCIATION embodying changes in Parish Council law  
due to Local Government re-organisation,  
would be available next Spring at £9.00 - but if ordered now for £7.00.

Agreed the Clerk be authorised to place a copy on order.

2533 PARISH BANKS The Chmn. declared an interest and left, handing the  
- RENTS (2511) Chair to the vice-Chairman for this item.

Members were most concerned that the Clerk had not written as instructed in  
MIN: 2511; he explained he had hoped for fuller information on past lapse  
of payments. Nevertheless, Council agreed, on prop. HWHE, sec. JGC, that  
the Clerk should give this matter priority with apologies to Mr. Pearson  
and ask for his acceptance of principle of liability for the relevant  
Bank Rents.
