Minutes of a Special Parish Council meeting held on Thursday  
15th September 1988 at 7.30pm in the Community Centre.

Apologies were received from R.J. Farrington and J. Harradine

351/88 Dispensing in Milton. R.D. proposed that a questionnaire  
be delivered to every house in the village to ascertain  
the village's views on the proposed pharmacy.

He had produced a draft questionnaire for discussion.

*Dispensing*

According to the Family Practitioner Committee (F.P.C.),  
Milton had been designated rural. The ~~pharmaceutical~~ *rural*  
~~practices~~ committee in London would be informed in  
approximately one month. E. Moss Ltd would then have  
30 days in which to appeal.

J.F.C.F. felt that the financial aspects (as circulated),  
would not be made public. As the financial side was an  
important part of the argument he proposed that no  
questionnaire be sent and that Council decide on action  
to be taken; that there was ample time to consult people  
and test opinions before taking a decision at the next  
meeting.

The F.P.C. welcomed the views of the village on its  
medical services and would be prepared to attend a  
public meeting.

It was agreed therefore to hold a public meeting within  
the next two weeks to which Dr. Draper and the F.P.C.  
would be invited.

R.D. consequently withdrew his proposal for a questionnaire.

L.M.L. and R.T.S. were not happy with the draft letter  
produced by E.M.C.D. (as proposed minute 325/88). It was  
agreed to rescind the decision therein.

Instead it was agreed that the clerk send a "holding"  
letter to the F.P.C.

The meeting ended at 8.18pm.
