3007 (3000) The Recreation Report had been circulated for all members to read. It was then agreed that the Council would reply to the letter from the Planning Officer (4.3.76) answering the specific matters of general principle as requested.

1. (Pages 47-50) Grant aid priorities P. Kiddle suggested we agree with the reported levels of priorities allocated but in the majority of category 3 items these would be better handled at local parish level or local voluntary organisations (parish council assisted) where the parish population is over 400. Thus by removing category 3 in this way parishes should be actively encouraged to press ahead with their own developments.
