# .... PROPOSED CATTLE MARKET NEAR KING'S HEDGES.

The Clerk read correspondence from the County Planning Office inviting the views on this proposal as being near the parish boundary. The site proposed is at the south end of the sewage farm to the east of the A.10.

The Chairman pointed out that this land was being farmed productively whereas, directly opposite was derelict land on the old camp, also conveniently near the railway and the main road, which could be used for the market.
