

SPECIAL MEETING OF MILTON PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT 7.30 p.m. ON JUNE 22nd TO INSPECT GRAY-CONOLEY LAND AND DECIDE ON LOCATION FOR TWO SEATS ON THE GREEN NEAR THE MEMORIAL.

2977 (2967) The Council examined the Gray Conoley site and felt that it should be 'opened' to villagers by means of cleared pathways. The Clerk would investigate costs of a contractor with equipment to cut necessary access routes. KPH offered to check the boundary line between the site and Marshalls flats-car park and the E.E. Sub Station. Posts may be needed to re-establish boundary fence.

2978 (2963) The Clerk would contact D. Haird regarding repair and installation of the two 'Dunn bequest' seats handed over by the V.H.M.C. The old notice board should be removed and a new one erected facing south. The seats would have to be modified for anchorage and inset with paving slabs.

This concluded the business and the Chairman closed the meeting.
