Matters arising from Minutes

Bus Shelters - The Clerk reported that he had provisionally agreed with the County Council a site, at the bus stop at Bene't Close for the erection of a bus shelter and that plans for the erection of this shelter and also a shelter at the Men's Institute had been submitted to the County Planning Department.

Traffic Sign - Church Lane - The County Surveyor stated that it was the practice of the Council to put up as few traffic signs as possible and to erect them only at places where they are vitally necessary. For this reason it was not deemed necessary to erect a "Slow - Major Road Ahead" sign in advance of the junction of Church Lane with another minor road, Fen Road. It was therefore agreed that a communication be sent to the Eastern Electricity Board asking for the co-operation of their staff in observing care when travelling from Milton Hall via Church Lane.

War Memorial Island - The County Council had now turfed the island and the Clerk was instructed to ask Mr. G. Mead, the Memorial Caretaker, if he would cut the grass when necessary.
