A SPECIAL MEETING OF MILTON PARISH COUNCIL THE VILLON FARM SCHOOL: WEDNESDAY JUNE: 23rd.1971

Two members of the County Planning Dept., Mr.T.G. Hardy and Mr.E.J. Wilson, accepted invitation to meet the Council for an unminuted discussion on Milton industrial planning, with particular reference to Ressrs Stoke's developments. The Council considered this a useful and informative discussion and the Chairman thanked the Officers for attending.

Following the discussion the following Council business was taken:

War Memorial Seat (1865) - The Clerk read a letter from Er.D. Thomas, wheen Anne Lodge, pointing out that, suffering as they already did from much rudeness from youths who frequented the War Memorial green, he asked if the seat it was proposed to place somewhat near their boundary could be sited on the other side of the green nearer Coles road.

The Council agreed this request seemed justified and that a seat may become an undesirable gathering place for dis-orderly youths. Agreed to erect the seat on the grass verge on the east side of scoles road, between the lay-by near the Sutches's shop and the sen road corner.
