MINUTES.

The Minutes of the meeting held on 29th July, 1958, were read, confirmed by the meeting, and signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES.

377. Mobile Showrooms - The Clerk reported that the two mobile showrooms had been removed and the site cleared.

378. Cycle Shop opposite the Wagon and Horses, P.H. - The Clerk reported that the site on which this shop stood had been acquired by the Ministry of Transport for the road diversion scheme, and the County Council were hopeful that the shop would be cleared away without delay.

379. Roadside Seat - Fen Road. - The County Council were of the opinion that it was not necessary for the Parish Council's insurance policy to be endorsed so as to indemnify the County Council, as both authorities were adequately covered.

380. Street Lighting - Fen Road - No reply had been received from the Rural District Council regarding the application for additional street lighting, but the Chairman reported that priority was being given to those parishes with no lighting at all, and unless it could be proved that street lighting covering the ten new dwelling in Fen Road was essential in the interests of road safety it was unlikely at the present time that lighting would be provided.

381. ALLOTMENTS.

The Clerk reported that Mr. H. Hall wished to relinquish the tenancy of Plots Nos. 5 and 6, containing $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres as from Michaelmas, 1958. The Chairman's action in letting these plots to Mr. H. Easy as from Michaelmas 1958, was confirmed.
