The Minutes of the Meeting held on 22nd May 1956,
were confirmed and signed.

Matters arising from Minutes.

201. Bus Shelter Lighting - The Clerk reported the District Auditor had confirmed that the energy charge for bus shelter lighting was properly a charge against the General Rate. Accordingly, it was unanimously agreed that that part of Minute No. 195 of the Meeting held on 22nd May 1956, relating to the payment of energy charge out of interest accumulated in the Post Office Savings Bank be rescinded, and that in future the energy charge be paid from the General Rate.
202. Sewage Disposal - Chesterton Rural District Council had intimated that they had given instructions to their employees to cease emptying cesspool contents into the Landbeach Road sewer.
203. ALLOTMENTS.
- The Clerk reported he had taken up with the County Land Agent the demand for 9/4d. deducted from allotment rent in respect of electricity poles, and had received notification that the Smallholdings Committee had passed a resolution that no wayleave payments will in future be refunded to the tenants, the full net rent being payable. On the proposition of Mr. S. A. Siggs, seconded by Mr. D. Pearson, it was agreed that a protest be lodged at this indirect increase in rent, and that the rightful person to receive any benefit arising from electricity poles wayleaves should be the tenant.
204. ADVERTISEMENT HOARDING - MILTON LAUNDRY.
- No objection was raised to the erection of an advertisement hoarding fitted with reflex lenses at Milton Laundry. It was understood that the sign was already in existence at this site advertising Ediswan products, although the actual contents of the advertisement may vary from time to time.
205. CARAVAN - FEN ROAD.
- The Clerk reported that he had received complaints concerning a caravan which had been parked in front of a bungalow near the School. He had reported the matter to the County Planning Officer

After discussion it was recommended that the Honorary Secretary be informed that the proposal to alter the title of "Milton Football Charity Cup" was viewed with disfavour.


