1. 293/88 Middleton's Pit. It was proposed R.D. seconded J.F.C.F. and agreed by all that Council accept Mumby & Sons quotation for drainage, landscaping works and reconstruction of roadway at extension to the recreation ground-total £6865. As the quotation for the roadway included work already done (removing of gravel and stones and building up of sub-base level to correct height) it was expected that this figure would be reduced accordingly .

2. 294/88 Public Open Space. It was agreed to pay £10,950 to Mumby as first payment for work done so far. This to be confirmed at the meeting of 22nd August.

3. Planning Application

295/88 S/1815/88 J.M. Barrett change of use of 37 High Street from private house to guest house. Concern about insufficient parking spaces for residents and number of visitors proposed. This could lead to increase in congestion on the road already caused by clientele of adjacent public house. Undesirable use of property in a residential area.
