



MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES.

Allotments - The Clerk reported that Mr. H. Capitain, 81, Coles Road, had taken over the tenancy of half-rood of allotments as from Michaelmas, 1962.

STREET LIGHTING.

Particulars were received from Chesterton Rural District Council of their street lighting proposals prepared in accordance with the Ministry of Transport recommendations, with whom discussions were taking place regarding the provision of Group A street lighting on the trunk road through the village. The proposals incorporated an additional 62 lamps.

It is anticipated that, subject to no delay in obtaining Ministerial approval, this scheme should be substantially complete by next winter.

BEST KEPT VILLAGE COMPETITION.

In view of the considerable development in progress it was agreed not to enter the competition this year.

PARKING OF VEHICLES ON GRASS VERGES.

The Clerk reported a letter from Mr. G. H. B. Rowlinson, West Manor, Butt Lane, Milton, complaining about the parking of motor vehicles on the strip of grass in front of the Council houses in Cambridge Road, and on the triangular pieces of grass at the entrance to Bene't Close. In addition he complained of the general untidiness of the village due to builders' plant and materials.

It was agreed that the matter of the parking of cars be referred to the County Planning Department.

In regard to the untidiness due to building operations, it was agreed that this matter be kept under review.
