
IMPINGTON VILLAGE COLLEGE MANAGING BODY.

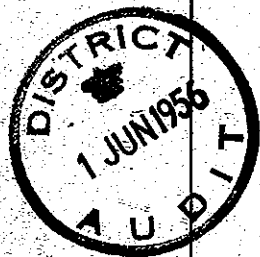
