348/96 S/1138/96 Mercury Communications Ltd
(343/96) Amendment showing increased size of building at Eastern Electricity.
For information only.

349/96 S/1314/96 Cambs County Council - Two classroom extension at Milton Primary School. Support the comments of a nearby resident as to the size of the building in close proximity to 8 Lyndhurst Close. It was felt that there was scope within the site to re-design the building.

350/96 S/1320/96 Hexagen Technology Ltd. Science Park - company name in individual letters. No objections.

351/96 S/1359/96 PLResearch
(297/96) Council supported this application in principle but had strong reservations (together with local residents) about an access on a road where there is already speeding traffic. A traffic calming measure e.g. a turning right lane/central refuge should be incorporated at the same time as the building of the access.

Sufficient parking on site needed to prevent 'ad hoc' parking elsewhere.
The clerk would request a meeting with J Selby and PT's landscape contractors to discuss details of the scheme.

Noted that Rev. Cowley had no objection to an entrance to the woods at the rear of Milton Hall through the churchyard - to be discussed with J Selby.

352/96 S/1387/96 Cambridge Consultants Ltd Science Park - Permanent car park extension for 21 spaces. Concerned that the original concept of landscaping (+ density of buildings) was steadily being lost.

355/96 **Litter and Street Cleansing Contract 1997**
(177/96) Noted that Milton was being included within the core services to be carried out by the successful contractor as from April 1997.

(264/96) Minutes of the meeting of the Rowing Trust Board of 26 July received and noted.

357/96 **Traffic - High Street and Cambridge Road**
(269/96) R Menzies having met with the Highways Committee had agreed to provide four pedestrian refuges in High Street/Cambridge Road to provide a series of crossing points for pedestrians.
Council supported these measures. RJF to discuss with R Menzies the siting of one refuge near 11 High Street since there had been an objection by a resident.
In order to build a mini island at Butt Lane the road (Butt Lane) would need strengthening. There was no money available for such work.
Noted that High Street/Cambridge Road was due to be resurfaced during this week.
Noted that the conifer hedge at 9 High Street was again encroaching over the footpath at probably the narrowest part of the road. The clerk to follow up.
