The Minutes of the meeting of 13 May 1996 were confirmed and signed as a true record.
- 252/96 **2. Decisions Received**
(198/96) The Waggon & Horses
RTS reported that the application for an extension had been refused on parking and traffic grounds.
- 253/96 **3. New Applications**
(107/96) S/0177/96 Childrens Hospice - The Long House Project
Amendment showing the lowering of the roof level by 2ft. It was felt that such a style of building was totally inappropriate for a conservation area and far too large for the site. Council supported Conservation Officer's reservations concerning removal of trees. Concern also about the inadequate narrow access in Church Lane. (min 155/96 also refers).
- 254/96 S/0691/96 GA Darley 35 Butt Lane - dropped kerb to give access to front garden. No objections.
- 255/96 S/0695/96 J Sandford 37 Butt Lane - new vehicular access to existing property. No objections. JS declared an interest.
- 256/96 S/0721/96 Bard Pharmaceuticals Ltd - purpose built enclosure to house pumping equipment serving the adjacent fire fighting water storage canal. No objections.
- 257/96 S/0733/96 East Waste Ltd Clay extraction and removal from Landfill Site. Concerns about the increase in traffic and the effect on the junction of the A10 and Butt Lane.
- 258/96 S/0737/96 Bard Pharmaceuticals Ltd - erection of site office (portakabin). Query that this was a temporary structure. Concerns that the original concept of landscaping and density of buildings at the Science Park was steadily being lost.

4. Any Other Planning Business259/96
(200/95)Eastern Electricity

RTS reported that enforcement action was being taken against Eastern Electricity as landscaping had not been completed at the time that the security fence was erected.
