Objections to change of use from residential. If change of use is granted it should be restricted to dental surgery only.

284/92 S/1108/92/LB Mrs. J. Clark, 3 High Street replacement of bricked up door. No objections.

S/1146/92 A. Sutcliffe and P. Nuttall change of use to golf practice centre including driving range and nine hole golf course at Penfold Farm, Ely Road. Contrary to Policies P20/4 of Cambs. Structure Plan and Policy GB3/1 of Cambridge Green Belt Local Plan in that "while outdoor sports are acceptable in Green Belt location policy GB3/2 only permits development in the open countryside where it will not adversely affect the rural and open nature of the area."

Objections also to the road access either via Landbeach Road or through the village. Increasing urbanisation.
