No external private amenity space constituting a form of overdevelopment out of character with the surrounding area. The building would adversely affect the amenities of neighbouring properties especially 14 Fen Road. Unacceptable building mass that would dominate this neighbour's garden.

The cramped design including a large void at ground level and limited space around the building would be out of character and inappropriate for a site within close visual proximity to the Conservation Area.
