1. Decisions Received

288/96

Mereway Poultry Farm Milton Road Impington

(57/96)

7 poultry buildings, egg packing station, bungalow and garage refused. Scale of expansion contrary to policies and aims of Cambridge Green Belt Local Plan which are supported by paragraph 3.15 of Planning Policy Guidance "Green Belts", resulting in a group of buildings out of character and scale with their surroundings.

The buildings would be difficult to screen adequately and therefore detrimental to the landscape being visible from the A10, the A14, Butt Lane and Mere Way. (139/96 also).

Waggon & Horse Public House extension - refused.

(252/96)

According to the Local Planning Authority's parking standards there was already a shortfall of 9 parking spaces. The extension would require an additional four parking spaces.

The development would result in increased floor space of the public house with the absence of any additional off street parking spaces. There would be greater on street parking, leading to increased noise and disturbance to nearby residents and highway danger. Increased on street parking would be detrimental to the character of the Conservation Area.
