A Milton corner is cleared. Final result 0 – 2. Hargrave Park went on to become champions. Milton escaped relegation on the last day of the season by goal difference.

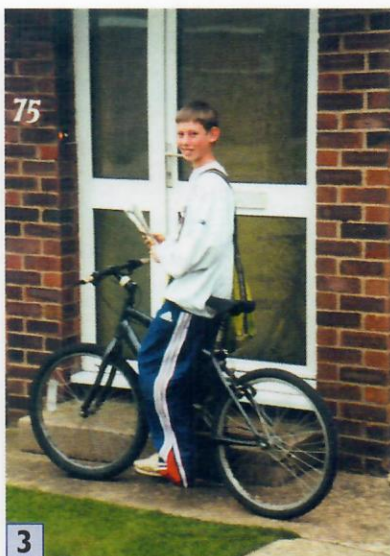

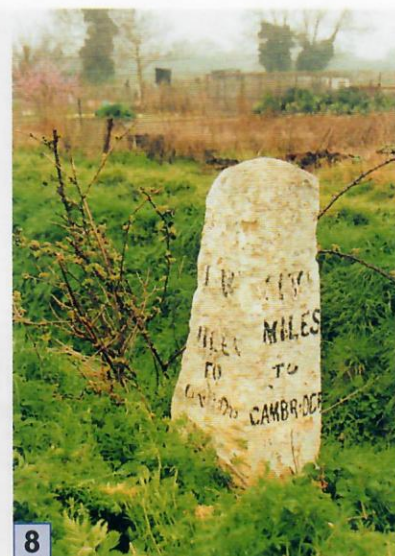

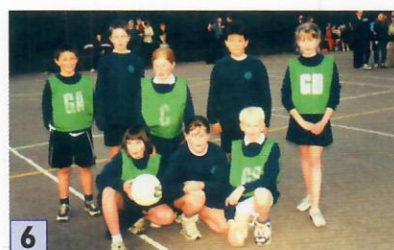
