

MILTON PARISH COUNCIL - AIMS

1. To provide and/or support the facilities needed for the improvement in quality of life for the inhabitants of Milton and in partnership with others (e.g. Milton Community Centre, Impington Village College) including facilities for:

Youth	Youth club Leisure Scouts etc
Elderly	Mobile Warden Scheme Community Transport
Leisure/Play	Play equipment sporting facilities - formal and informal community facilities
Allotments	Provision of facilities for the gardeners
Cemetery	Milton PC is a burial authority and provides a cemetery which is a place of quiet in an attractive setting for families and friends to visit.

2. To support the whole community by:-
 - i. grant aiding the Community Centre and recreation grounds;
 - ii. protecting and maintaining the environment through:-
 - a. grass cutting;
 - b. planting and maintenance of shrubs/trees throughout the village;
 - c. planting bulbs e.g. daffodils;
 - d. working in partnership with Cambridge Sport Lakes Trust including Milton's own Nature Reserve Tomkins Mead;
 - e. litter picking;
 - f. promoting cycle schemes thus encouraging less dependence on cars;
 - iii. ensuring residents' concerns are heard in relation to planning applications.
 - iv. working with the police and local Neighbourhood Watch schemes to reduce crime and the fear of crime when appropriate.
 - v. keeping the costs of administration to a minimum.
 - vi. having an interest in the well-being, development and growth of young people through education.
